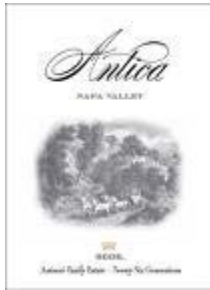

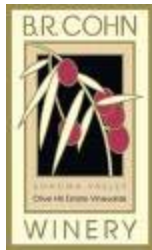

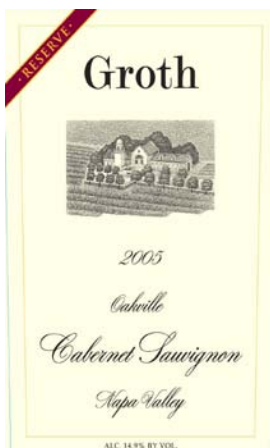
**Cabernets Sauvignons Featured -**



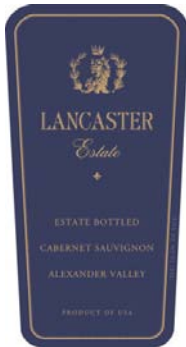
**Antica, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, '06:** Antica is an Antinori Family estate in Napa Valley. The family's winemaking heritage dates back 26 generations and over 600 years in Italy. 'Antica' represents Antinori California, and fulfills the family's longstanding desire to produce wines with personality and style in Napa Valley.



**BR Cohn, Cabernet Sauvignon, Olive Hill, '06** - B.R. Cohn is a small family-operated winery is surrounded by the 90-acre Olive Hill Estate Vineyards, where soils warmed by underground natural hot springs and gentle ocean breezes create a unique microclimate, resulting in ideal growing conditions for Cabernet Sauvignon. Bruce Cohn, founder and proprietor of B.R. Cohn Winery, has embraced a lifelong passion for Northern California's wine country and its bounty. An equally strong passion for music led to a parallel career in the music industry as the manager for one of rock 'n' roll's perennially favorite American bands, The Doobie Brothers. His down-to-earth attitude, focus and dedication have made both careers flourishing successes to this day.



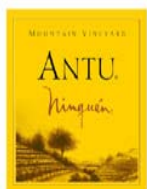
**Groth, Cabernet Sauvignon, Oakville '06** - Dennis and Judy Groth, are natives of the Santa Clara Valley. Dennis was one of the key architects that built Atari, a consumer electronic company, into a 2 billion dollar company. Groth Vineyards & Winery was established in 1982 and produces Cabernet Sauvignon, Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay from Napa Valley's Oakville AVA.



**Lancaster, Estate Cabernet, Alexander Valley, '05** - Lancaster Estate is a family owned winery, dedicated to crafting wines that are Estate grown, bottled, and produced. Situated on 53 hillside acres at the southern tip of Alexander Valley, near the confluence of the Knights Valley and Chalk Hill appellations, this location enjoys the warm climate, depleted soils, and rugged hillsides uniquely suited to growing Bordeaux varieties. This is a fabulous Cabernet worth splurging and taking a bottle home.

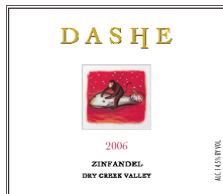


**Mauritsen Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma County, '06** - The Mauritsen family were grape growers in Dry Creek Valley and decided to dream big and open their own winery. The results speak for themselves, winemaking that showcases the subtleties and strengths of each micro-climate within the Dry Creek, Rockpile and Alexander Valleys. I had the pleasure of meeting winemaker Clay Mauritsen. A super nice guy who makes delicious Cabernet, Zin and Sauvignon Blanc. The wines show beautiful fruit and elegance.



**MontGras Antu Ninquen, Cabernet Sauvignon/Carmenere, Chile '06** - Paul Hobbs, a leading California winemaker with an international reputation for developing world-class South American wines, works closely with owner Hernán Gras and winemaker Santiago Margozzini to craft the limited production Antu wines from the Ninquén Mountain Estate vineyard. The range takes its name from the word for "sun" in the language of the ancient Mapuche people who once inhabited this part of Chile.

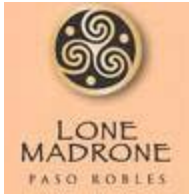
## Zinfandels Featured -



**Dashe Cellars, Zinfandel, Dry Creek, '07** - In 1996, the husband and wife winemaking team of [Michael](#) and [Anne](#) Dashe founded Dashe Cellars. Focused on crafting exceptional single vineyard wines, Dashe Cellars blends [Anne's](#) classic French winemaking training with the experience [Michael](#) has gained at such noted American wineries as Ridge Vineyards, Far Niente and Schramsberg Wine Cellars. Together, the Dashe's strive to create authentic, vineyard-focused wines that capture the charm and personality of top, independent vineyards throughout Sonoma County and beyond. \*Single-vineyard Zinfandels will also be included in this tasting.



**Kunde, Reserve Zinfandel, Century Vines, Sonoma Valley '05** - Family owned and operated for five generations, Kunde Family Estate produces ultra-premium, estate-grown wines that are sustainably farmed in the finest traditions of Northern California's renowned Sonoma Valley. Israel, our busser at Cin-Cin loves this wine. After we had a tasting of many Zinfandels, Israel said - "muy bueno" to this one. Taste and see if you agree!



**Lone Madrone Zinfandel, Paso Robles, '06** - Lone Madrone has been making wines on the central coast of California since 1996. Winemaker Neil Collins believes strongly that in order to produce wines of the highest caliber you must first start with grapes that are of exceptional quality. Neil Collins has been making the wines and tending to the vineyard operations for Tablas Creek Vineyards since 1998. The wines he produces for Tablas Creek are among the best Rhone varietals produced in California, and he brings this same passion and quest for excellence to his own Lone Madrone wines.



**Mauritson, Zinfandel, Dry Creek Valley, '07** - 2007 was an outstanding year for Zinfandel in Dry Creek Valley, possibly one of the best in the last fifteen years. The growing season was all but perfect. Also, there is nearly forty percent Rockpile fruit in it, this could be Mauritson's best Dry Creek Valley Zinfandel ever. My parents visited Mauritson winery and loved the Zinfandels there. Surprisingly, my parents are not Zinfandel lovers, yet they ended up buying quite a few wines from Mauritson.



**Sobon Estate, "Rocky Top" Zinfandel Amador County'07 (organic)** - Paul Sobon has been in the Wine Industry since the family founded Shenandoah Vineyards. Since 1983, he has been directly involved in the daily operations and growth of the 40,000 case winery and 125 acres of Sustainably-farmed Wine Grapes. Sobon Zinfandel has been a mainstay at Cin-Cin.
